DANVILLE PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S SCHOLARSHIP — DUE MARCH 28

URW COMMUNITY FCU SCHOLARSHIP — DUE APRIL 8

URW Community Federal Credit Union will grant up to 10 scholarships to high school seniors graduating in 2016 continuing on to an accredited college (or recognized institution of higher learning) in the 2016-2017 school year. COLLEGE TESTING

SAT Test: The fee is \$54.50. You can register online at www.collegeboard.com. Our school code is 470-669. The SAT will be given on the following dates: May 7 (register by April 8), and June 4 (register by May 5).

Sophomores: This year, there is a new PSAT 10 test, designed for sophomores, who would like to begin the college entrance testing process. Any Sophomore who wants to take the new PSAT 10 at WCA on March 1, 2016 may do so — especially if you are in Algebra 2 this year. The cost of the PSAT 10 is \$15 per student. Please sign up for the test by bringing the \$15 to Mrs. Crozier by FRIDAY, February 19.

MILITARY ACADEMY DAY — SATURDAY, APRIL 23
