We will be celebrating a "Spring Break" with the following schedule:

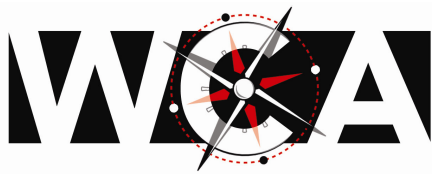
